There are many different types of wills that you can have depending upon your circumstances. Some may be relevant for you and some may not, so we have tried to make it easy for you to spot what you may need.

Wills for individuals, not married with no children

This will works for you if you meet the following criteria:-

- You are single
- You do not have children
- You have assets under £325,000
- You do not run a business or operate a farming business

These will cost £250 plus VAT ie £300 to prepare

Wills for married couples, with children

This will works for you if you meet the following criteria:-

- You are married
- You have children
- You have assets under £650,000
- You do not run a business or operate a farming business

These will cost £350 plus VAT ie £420 per couple to prepare together with any disbursements which may apply as detailed below

Wills for divorced individuals with children

Things can begin to get a little complex when you have divorced. This will works for you if:-

- You are divorced
- You are cohabiting with another
- You have remarried
- You have a mix of children from different relationships

These will cost £650 plus VAT ie £780 per couple together with any disbursements which may apply as detailed below

Wills for families with children with physical or invisible disabilities

When you are a parent of a child with disabilities priorities change completely and you want to make sure, above all else, that your children are safe and protected for their future. This is where it is necessary to consider using trusts.

These will cost £1000 plus VAT ie £1,200 per couple together with any disbursements which may apply as detailed below

Wills to protect assets against care charges

People are now more concerned about losing their hard earned savings in paying for care should circumstances arise. Whilst there is only a small number of people who do eventually require long term care would you not feel happier if you had done everything you could to protect inheritance for your children.

These will cost £1000 plus VAT ie £1,200 per couple together with any disbursements which may apply as detailed below

More complex wills

If you have estates in excess of £650,000, have assets abroad, run your own business or farm you will require specialist advice which incorporates tax planning advice. To prepare wills to include tax planning advice costs will be between £1000 and £2500 plus VAT ie £1,200 and

£3,000 depending upon your circumstances together with any disbursements which may apply as detailed below.

Other charges

Disbursements

These are fees that are payable to third parties other than Argo for other services that may be provided. You may encounter the following charges:-

H M Land Registry office copy entry fee	£3 to £6 per property
H M Land Registry land charges	subject to valuation of property

There may be other services that you require in relation to the completion of your wills. These could be:-

Letters of wishes	£150 plus VAT ie £180
Notices of severance	£150 plus VAT ie £180
